Update: Impact Bargaining
CUSD Pulls the Rug Out on
Employees with Childcare Needs!

CUSD Colleagues:

Although we have not reached an agreement, CAUSE Leadership has been able to confirm one detail:

"Visitors, family members including children, volunteers, pets. an/or any non-district employees are NOT to be on campus."

What does this mean:

- a. Just five days before students return for the 2020-21 school year, the CUSD has unilaterally decided to prohibit District employees from bringing their children onto District school-sites & facilities.
- b. Not only is this announcement in conflict with the guidance previously provided by select District Principals; at this late hour the timing couldn't be worse. District employees are now left scrambling for quality childcare, with less than a week notification.
- c. Given the limited options before us, the Union is compelled to share the terms of the "Family First Coronavirus Response Act," which clarifies the newest LEAVE options related to the COVID-19 pandemic. These options, coupled with our current contractual LEAVE provisions (afforded all CUSD employees) may be the only way District employees can resolve this issue in the limited time we've been provided.
