In the last month, CUSD stakeholders have witnessed district administration's posturing around the pursuit of a reopening WAIVER. Given the CUSD's current HEALTH & SAFETY preparedness, many have observed that even pursuing such a WAIVER under the current conditions would demonstrate a dismissal of the ongoing significant threats that COVID-19 brings our students, district employees, and their families.

Fortunately, school board leaders in other surrounding school districts are taking the <u>lead!</u>

Surrounding regional Districts are beginning to publicly acknowledge that seeking IN-PERSON reopening WAIVERS would be a wreckless approach at this time. Although CUSD's Board Members have done little to lead in this area, school board leaders in surrounding Districts are making it clear. Even with a district's effort to meet the guidelines associated with a reopening WAIVER, local school districts simply do not have sufficient resources or know enough about the virus to reopen (IN-PERSON) in a SAFE and HEALTHY manner.
